Membership Guidelines

The following information will help answer questions you may have about your membership in Town and Country Garden Club.

MEETINGS

Meetings are usually held the first Wednesday morning of the month from October through June, and the second Wednesday morning in September. We do not meet in July and August.

Meetings include a social time, program and business meeting. They typically begin at 8:30 a.m. and end before noon. Members are expected to attend all meetings. If you are unable to attend a meeting, you must call or send an email message to the hosts/hostesses, the recording secretary and the President prior to the meeting. Meeting times and locations are listed in the *Yearbook*, and in our *Call to Meeting*, which includes updated and more complete information about the time, location, program, and hosts/hostesses for the upcoming meeting.

Meetings take place in members' homes or public places. Members are expected to serve as a host/hostess by holding a meeting in their home or as a co-hostess in providing refreshments, table décor, and floral arrangements.

DUES

Active and Limited Active Member dues are \$125, Affiliate Member dues are \$100, which are to be paid by the June annual meeting. First year Active Member dues are \$63, payable upon acceptance to the Club.

PARTICIPATION

- a. Active Members are expected to participate in Club projects, events, and fundraisers, and are required to serve on Standing Committees, Civic Project Teams, and ad hoc Committees.
- b. A first year member is considered an Active Member, who can vote and endorse candidates for membership, but does not join a Standing Committee, Civic Project Team, or pay full dues until June.
- c. A first year member of the Club and their proposer shall attend at least one committee meeting of either Conservation, Horticulture, or Floral Design Committees and may also attend other committee meetings.
- d. Participation in Indian Mound Park maintenance, Downtown Planters, and fundraising events is required by all Active Members.

Active Members may vote, hold office, propose and endorse new members, serve as delegates to Annual and Zone Meetings, hold a national office, and participate in GCA programs. First year members have some special guidelines. Active Members may request Limited Active membership status for personal or family reasons.
